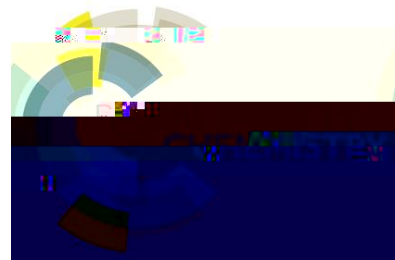


## RED EVENT – risk assessment form (EXAMPLE)



### Event details

### Hazards and control measures

| <b>Hazards</b>   | <b>Control measures</b>   |
|--|---|
| Description of hazard (chemicals, activity and potential harm, e.g. burns, inhalation of fumes, noise) | State measures, other than the minimum safety requirements detailed below   |
| Eye/skin irritation caused by prolonged exposure to UV light   | Low intensity UV light suitable for experiments of this nature used – should be no danger from skin exposure.   |
| Skin allergy to pen or cosmetics used  | All creams used are hypoallergenic, participants are asked to declare if they have an allergy. Those with skin allergies will be asked to refrain from taking part but can watch. |

The minimum safety requirements for demonstrations/activities are:

- Minimum quantities of hazardous substances used and present at the demonstration/activity
- Maximum dilutions (minimum concentration) of substances
