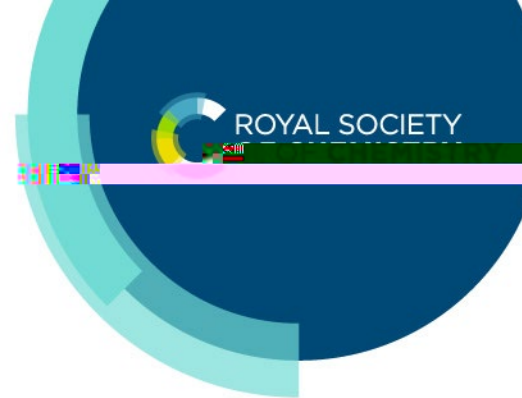


# Evidence Submission
